



High School Equivalence (HSE)

Adult Basic Education (HSE) classes help adult students improve their reading, writing, and math skills in order to take the high school equivalency exams, and/or prepare for college entrance exams.

Residents of Massachusetts who desire to earn a high school equivalency credential have the choice of two exams: GED and HiSET. The Abisi Adult Education Center (AAEC) is an official testing center for both exams. The successful completion of either the GED or HiSET exam will earn a Massachusetts high school credential, opening up doors for college and better career opportunities.



Denise manages the HiSET® and GED® computer-based testing.
She is here to answer your questions about the exams. She can also help with registration and special accommodations.





Abisi Adult Education Center is an official Test Center for the HiSET and the GED exams. These exams are the pathway to earn a High School credential in Massachusetts. Candidates are awarded the credential when they have successfully passed all subject tests in one, or a combination of both exams. Upon completion, the Credential must be ordered from DiplomaSender.com.

HiSET tests can be taken on either paper or a computer. GED tests are only available on a computer.

Throughout the school year, the AAEC Test Center schedules one testing weekend each month. Paper-based HiSET appointments and GED appointments begin on Friday night at 5pm, and resume the following Saturday morning at 8am. Candidates can take multiple tests between the two days.

AAEC also offers computer based appointments on some Thursday afternoons at 12:30pm, rotating the HiSET and the GED each time.

Schedules will be announced in the Melting Pot newsletter and posted around the school.

If you have any questions about the GED or the HiSET exams, please see Denise in the LAB. She is here on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.


