Reflection on Current practices

ILT continually reviews data in order to drive future instruction. Teams meet at CPT's to review data and form plans for future instruction.

Bailey continues to make progress. Students with disabilities are not making the same progress. When looking at the service grids this may be because students with disabilities who are grouped together may have differing needs (ex. Student working on decoding grouped with a student working on comprehension)

Students with social emotional needs need more support. Staff need more support/straining to help these students.

Smaller groupings are needed to make sure all students are making gains.

Leadership – ILT, PBIS, Culture, and Data teams will keep Google doc notes so that everyone has access to what these teams are working on.

Data – Google doc will be kept to monitor use/skills/strategies Monthly PD to build capacity for effective skill/strategy groups Student specific supports

Keeping the same staff as last year with the addition of 1 ELL teacher and 4 ELL tutors.

Needs to buy 2 more computer carts for the rollout of ST math (8,000 per computer cart with 30 computers in them) 16,000 total

District has a technology budget that they haven't proposed yet. If the proposal includes a computer cart for our school we would have 8,000.

SSC decides backup plan for the 8,000 dollars would be to keep the part time parent liaison on.
