- Student Data in Open Architecture, teacher data is not loaded yet
- Spring 2024 - 751 students completed part of the survey
- Fall 2024 - 2208 students completed part of the survey
- Relationships of students in the school
  - Spring 24 to Fall 24 increased by 0.10, from 3.15 to 3.25 out of a total of 5.0
- The leadership team is analyzing the data and they will report in the future

6:27 PM - Enrollment Update – (Rose Mendonca)

- 🟡 241120 - 2024 Enrollment Data - Reviewed the document in the meeting
- 337 students have been served since August 2024

- 299 students have enrolled at LHS
- 320 have withdrawn - Most are of working age, some are not going to graduate with their class
- 3,363 are enrolled in LHS as of the date of the report
- Age 17-21 can't be turned away if they want to enroll at LHS
  - Brocton new students who fit the criteria, come in as a junior and complete and pass 12 courses at night, a subset of the Adult Ed, and they get a diploma in 2 years
  - Other schools also have similar type programs
  - Look into how other schools handle this
