- Open house in November: Jimmy will work with Matt and Jannay to set up a table to garner parent involvement in SSC.
- Reviewed meeting dates for the year
- Reviewed the Open Architects Database
 - Further explained how it will help to MCAS and other important data points.
 - Can sort by indicators: Math modules, EL's, etc
 - Working to correlate with our Tier III's and data around student support given supports that have been added over time. (ELD, Community Schools, SEL tutors, VP#2)
 - Sort on incidents gives an indication on struggling (Tier III) students
 - Multiple variables contribute to these factors. We do have control over what scaffold and curriculum that we present to these students.
 - Data shows us that suspensions do not work and further disconnect students from school
 - No magic fix for individual students however, prescriptions for each student will lead to growth and progress.
 - Literacy is top priority: Interventions include LLI, ELD, in class interventions etc.
 - Data Platform is evolving to meet the needs of teachers and administrators
 - Attendance, IEPs, EL's, demographics, etc.
 - Chronic absenteeism has been higher over the last few years, but our numbers are improving. We have an attendance team that works to mitigate the issues that connect to this.
 - Student supports work hard to address the needs of our high risk students.
 - Positive supports in place: We have over 200 students in the after school program
 - Tier III supports in tandem with Matt G. work, police academy, after school program, SEL supports with care Solis, TAT's, including programming outside of the building support these students.
 - Katy is presenting a key parent list and working on building relationships. Acknowledges that responses from middle school parents are tough. Use the SMORE as a mechanism but also make hard copies available too. We need to get information to parent about how to translate the information on the newsletter. Add the directions in 4 four different languages that are most common for our population at the top of the Smore.
 - Clever is tied to X2 and it will translate too.
