- **1 Full-Time Bilingual Parent Liaison** (the part-time job did not attract candidates due to the low salary but a full-time job may be much more enticing) \$43,179 -voted to pass
- 1 Full-Time Intervention Teacher (supporting tier 2 interventions in literacy & math) \$100,362 -voted to pass
- 1 K-4 SPED Para (currently only have 3 of them; adding a 4th will increase inclusion support) \$38,213.54 -voted to pass
- **2 18-hour Tutors** (will bring us to 7 in total and allow for more math or writing support if we flex hours) \$50,400 -voted to pass
- 1 Library Teacher (grant-funded for this year- not out of our budget- move Mary Wood) -grant funded for next year
- \$15,000 for Contracted Services for PD on inclusive practices and new SEL curriculum -voted to pass
- \$67,101.46 to the General Fund for a total of \$105,027.46: -voted to pass
 - \$10,000 to purchase SEL program K-8
 - \$25,000 to fund arts enrichment programs (guest artists, performances, festival fees, supplies for arts pathways classes, instrument repair PO)
 - \$16,000 for individual teacher supplies (\$400 per teacher for choice items for classrooms)
 - \$10,000 for a storage shed for costumes, staging, etc.
