Principal's Report: Matt Stahl

- ~Feedback needed for QIP. Fair Student Funding Formula for Special Education, ELS, low income students etc. for each student. Last year's budget was around \$5,700,000. Extra money can be used for Supply Budget, Web Sites/Programs, Standing Desks, etc.
- ~No major changes to the budget for next year. Possibly an adjustment for PPE.
- ~Adjustment Students may possibly return on February 1, 2021. Nine students were in person previously and one student was remote.
- ~The 25% of the student population that were in school in the fall may return on March 1, 2021. There were 180 students in this group.
- ~Will teachers be able to teach both in person and remote learning depends on the Teachers" Union.
- ~April 1, 2021 is the tentative date for 50% of the students to return to school. That is 300-350 students.
- ~All return dates are contingent on COVID numbers and the agreement between the Central Office and the Union.
- ~In regards to staffing, all teaching positions have been filled. There is a One to One Paraprofessional Position and five Paraprofessional Positions open.

President's Report: Coralie Cote

- ~Fundraising may be done right after February Vacation. Cherrydale gives a 40% profit and items can be shipped to the homes. Genevieve's may be out of business.
- ~Calendar Raffle Fundraiser will be done in April.
- ~Yankee Candle Fundraiser will be done in May and items can be shipped directly to the homes.

Treasurer's Report: Tina Novo

- ~Waiting to hear back from the Friends of Lowell High School about the Wang Scholarship.
- ~No changes to the Checking and Savings Accounts.

New Business

- ~Clothing orders are in. There were about 25-30 orders placed.
- ~MCAS Testing is still on the table. They may be done in April or May, but may get cancelled.
